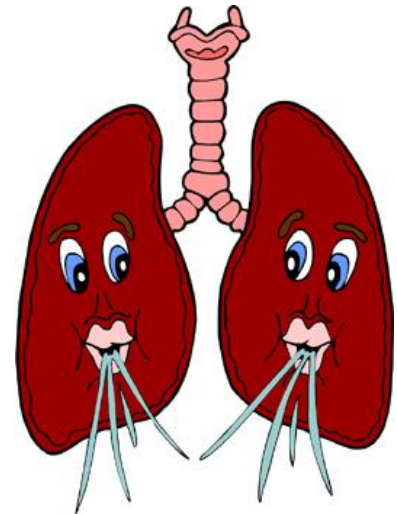
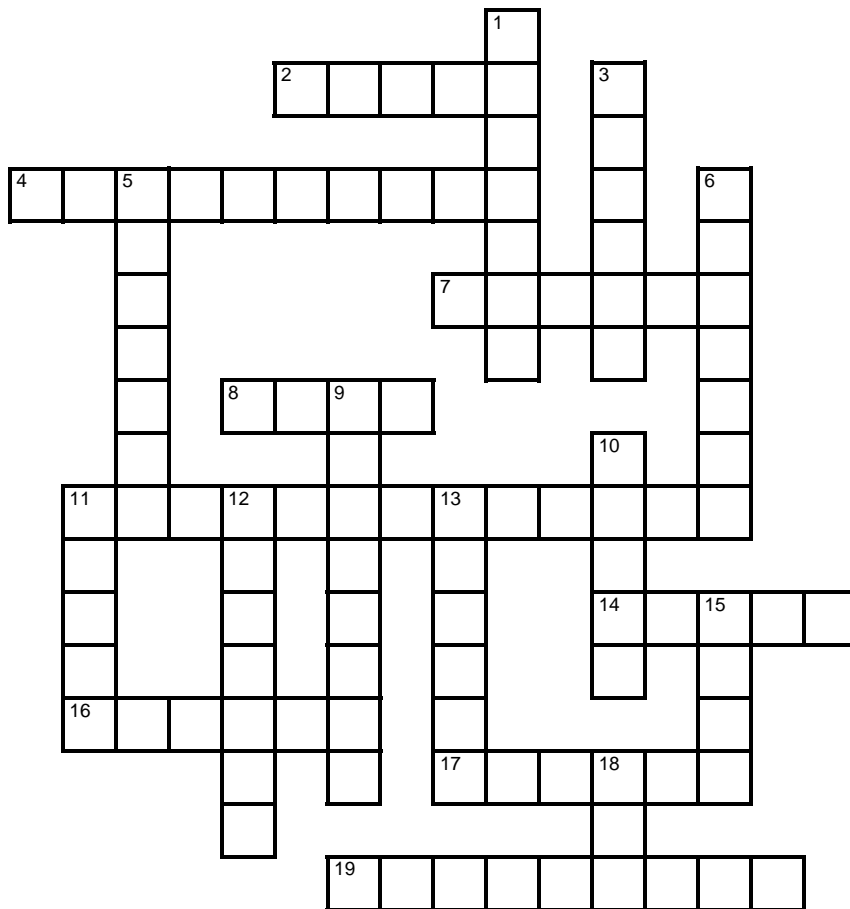




The Respiratory System
